Requirements

Applicants must:

- Have a TEFL certificate (or equivalent) issued by a reputable institution. Subject to the review by 4DS.
- Be native English speakers
- Be 21 years of age or older, at time of start of assignment.
- Have a college degree.
- Have a valid passport. Although only a tourist permit is required to enter Mexico.
- Applicants must be myriad-minded, flexible, independent, and in good health.

- Must enjoy working with children, teens or adults, at either schools, language centers or within a company.
- Be available to work mornings and/or evenings.
- Submit a cover letter and resume. Upon request, we may provide formats for you to adapt your own.
- Once you have been accepted. 4DS requires a U.S. \$152.00 non-refundable deposit. The remaining balance of U.S.\$608.00 is due two weeks prior to established date for arrival in Mexico

Salary expectations:

A certified teacher expects to make from 500 - 600 U.S. dollars a month at the beginning of a teaching position in most Latin American countries, although salaries may increase upon experience, performance and / or educational degrees that you may already have. An English teacher/tutor works an average of 30-40 hours per week – approximately 6-8 classes per day (The schedule can be arranged between you and the school).
